| Business Arising from last meeting | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Community Plan presentation to WSC on Saturday 20th well received event – 150 attended at weir wall. Thanks to SRW [Darren [for support. Leon Bannister to draft media release for Shire and local newsletters. Feedback from the event confirms that communication of activates and information is still an issue. ■ Access to copies of community plan/summary format required to be refined – Copies to be placed in Coongulla Hall and Fire Station. Glenmaggie to be followed up. ■ Community Notice Board – program outlined and funding has been secured for both Coongulla and Glenmaggie Boards. Glenmaggie board to be located in front of Mechanics Institute. | Water/Sewerage: | <p>Water Quality and Sewerage Scheme Delivery timetable delays raised with Gippsland Water – no reply to date. WSC Councilor Malcolm Hole requested from CRG confirmation of Sewerage Scheme cost quotes from CRG files – supplied by DS</p> <p>Media and private correspondence [circulated at meeting] indicates that Gippsland Water [GW] has changed its focus from a reticulated sewerage scheme and is investigating a septic solution. Discussion on history and interaction with GW on the project. Resolved that CRG should write to GW and clarify that the 5 previous identified solutions will now be 6 and request a meeting to discuss program forward and CRG representation/communication.</p> <p>Action: David Sullivan to draft letter</p> |
| Recreational Management: | <p>Trail Bike, David Sullivan – Proposed focus meeting Friday 26th Sept, outlined agencies contacted to attend, which included SRW, WGCMA, DSE, Vic Pol – After meeting at WSC Partners Program [20th Aug] with DSE representative it became clear that there was already a Trail Bike Focus Group established and that they have already started on some local goals and objectives – Suggested that when their current project [Cheynes Bridge – unloading area] is completed this would be an effective model to use as a positive outcome to move on LG issues – recommend joining existing focus group in lieu of proposed focus meeting.</p> <p>Action: David Sullivan to follow up.</p> |
| Roads, Speeding Management: | <p>David Sullivan advised on feedback from Vic Roads at WSC Partners Program meeting evening re vehicle speed / roads management – advises that it MAY be possible to utilize a seasonal speed signage program, that is used for small town on the coast to cope with the influx of visitor traffic during the summer months. Wellington Street and Katrina Cres speed management issues also highlighted and has been previously discussed with WSC. Will follow up with WSC re concept</p> |
