Lanigan's bridge – Operational on Thursday 20<sup>th</sup> March, minor works such as approach barriers and signage to be completed.</li> <li>• Lakeside Caravan Parks lack of progress – SRW advises that capital works such as boilers and cabling were priority for new contract arrangements. <b>Water</b>	Gippsland Water advised that water quality of the Coongulla reticulated system is of required standard despite continued poor raw water quality in river. The system upgrade is performing well. In the event of significant rain events in the catchment then restrictions may be required. Sewerage program has been confirmed in the Essential Services Commission water price review draft decision to on Friday 28 <sup>th</sup> March 2008.
<b>Recreational Management:</b>	Registration for DSE Trail Bike Management Briefing program to be conducted May 2008
<b>Sewerage:</b>	Submission to Essential Services Commissioner tabled by D Sullivan – Expressing concern over 5 year delay, decrease in funding by DSE lack of priority overall. Phone reply from Water Commissioner Mr. Crees today acknowledge community concern over delay however project has been included in GW draft 5 year plan, project completion may go beyond 2013. Public Submissions to Draft plan due 9 <sup>th</sup> May – D.S recommends attendance at public meeting 28 <sup>th</sup> April TBA and lodge public submission.

<b>Glenmaggie Truss Bridge</b>	<p>Glenmaggie residents concerned about possible structural issues and lack of maintenance – taken to WSC at Heyfield Shire meeting. WSC confirmed that bridge is a working piece of historical infrastructure [ listed on the Victorian National Trust Register] and as such will be maintained accordingly. May require additional community support into the future to ensure its operational status. <b>Resolved to include issue in next community survey.</b></p>
