

2009 Lake Glenmaggie CRG Community Survey - Additional Comments

Community Issues

- none except basketball hoop in Coongulla park
- Reduction of fuel on properties
- More police activities during busy periods
- waterfront kept clear of rubbish and timber and dead trees
- keep community areas clean...tennis courts, play grounds
- Without more interaction in the town, I don't believe the town will prosper and grow
- Coongulla is at risk of a major fire tragedy. Needs a huge clean up. A "Kinglake" waiting to happen
- Improve R.S.L Facilities
- We need a shop at Coongulla
- Play area on edge of Lake
- More police to check unregistered motor bikes etc.
- Upgrade and beautification of tennis courts and play equipment at the Hall
- Water front kept clean of rubbish/timber and dead trees or draining of the Lake
- Another market in Coongulla, ie. Cup weekend in November
- Delivery of mail to letter boxes in front of houses.
- Maintain the existing tennis courts
- Holding CRG meetings at a better time for people living in the city, eg. Saturday afternoon.
- Dogs running free, threatening people and animals
- Activities for boats and bikes should not be stopped, maybe better managed as to speed and Rec. licenses

Recreational Issues

- Not interested in encouraging more tourists or visitors in Coongulla. There is no parking or access
- A pay phone in the caravan park and camping grounds in area for emergencies
- Motorbikes around town are unregistered noisy dangerous, dangerous behaviour by jet skiers
- Encourage boating, both power and sail
- Fix tennis courts / Improved maintenance and cleanliness around Coongulla playground/tennis courts
- Noise and dust from motorbikes dust goes on roof an mixes with rain which we then end up drinking
- Four wheel drive tracks to remain open
- Tennis courts improved, Parking for cars around lake when water levels high , Stairs access swimming area in Coongulla cove when water level high, instead of climbing down/up steep rocky bank.
- Maps for walking trails in area on notice board
- Boating and Rec. m/bike riding needs to be retained
- Better policies and assistance for boating & motor bike behaviour. More presence of appropriate authorities
- Toilets at boat ramp at Coongulla
- Perhaps BBQ's at old school site at Glenmaggie
- Present caravan park is a blot on the landscape. Needs total make over and landscaped. At present area is off putting for visitors and residents
- Bike tracks so they don't go on roads. Tracks for riding horses on is most important
- Remove sediment in Lake and debris associated with floods
- Recreational activities for youth (bike track etc.)
- Ensure boating activities remain on Glenmaggie at all times & ensure buoys are moved according to water levels as they change
- No day visitor facilities/picnic area/public toilets in Glenmaggie township

Environmental Issues

- More planned burn offs
- Houses on Lake still send sewerage into lake
- People camping on blocks with no facilities
- We have picked up a lot of rubbish in the past near the boat ramp but there is no bin to put it in so we have to carry it home which can be hard when we also have small children with us
- Noisy bikes in and around town and on lake bed, un-muffled boats, boat and jet ski operators near houses who impact on others
- Allowing people to camp on blocks with no septic or sewerage. People placing sheds and shipping crates on blocks and we have to live with it
- Residents removing trees etc & altering foreshore without appropriate permission, this should be policed by appropriate authority
- Fuel reduction burning
- Rubbish around lake is disgusting. Fuel reduction burning needs to be done in some areas
- Improve rubbish removal during holiday periods, more rubbish bins to be supplied around Lake areas
- Sewerage is the most important thing
- Sewerage system would enable me to build on my waterfront property
- Clean up logs from coves
- Issue of Lake side rubbish and recreational management should be dealt with by SRW & WSC
- Sewerage would correct most of the problems with water quality
- Not to be over done, but more police checks on boats and motor cycles
- Silting of Lake
- Disappearance of wildlife due to habitat degeneration & clearing of bush land

Infrastructure Issues

- Lighting around the streets always out very difficult to report as lake of numbers on houses and holiday houses don't tend to notice or report
- May I suggest you look into possibly using the old Glenmaggie school site for toilet facilities most likely to already have a septic system
- Better mobile phone service (7 comments)
- More regular grading of roads
- Glenmaggie bridge must be kept open
- Lack of public toilets, CRG should be able to do something about this
- Street signage, slow down, school bus signs
- Maintenance of grassed areas around the Lake
- You cannot get into the toilets at the caravan park
- Drainage is bad at Hurley rd, Glenmaggie, every time we get heavy rain
- Because of poor drainage our roads suffer badly
- The reserve on Ryans Road has become a disgrace, eg. People making their own roads through the reserve ruining the place.
- Access road to Coongulla an issue, some of the bends need widening
- Unsealed roads need sealing, down residential streets
- Roads and streets are most appropriate for the area. It would be sad to over improve the structural condition of the local streets & roads; just maintain them
- Roads are scraped only, there are 5 year olds riding bikes on these roads
- Slowing traffic down in Coongulla, speed humps in Tamboritha Tce.
- My property becomes a lake when heavy rains come - Coongulla
- History of town displayed, signs for landmarks and events
